

# Learn to Sail (RYA Level 1 and/or 2) Bexhill Sailing Club 2024

The course will run for eight consecutive Saturdays, starting 8th June, ending 27<sup>th</sup> July 2024. Sessions will be mornings (0900-1300) or afternoons (1300-1700) to make best use of the tidal conditions.

There will also be the Sail Training regatta, with some informal fun races, on the afternoon of Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

In addition there will be an **Induction Morning** on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2024 10am at the Club, which is very important for you to attend.

On joining the course you will become a member of Bexhill Sailing Club with all the benefits of membership until the end of the course. On successful completion of the course you become eligible for an ex gratia membership until the end of the membership year and also have free use of Club boats, subject to conditions. You will be taught in single-handed and/or double-handed boats.

The course fee is **£395.00**

The remaining £300 is to be paid on or before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024.
